## THE CAREFREE EXPERIENCE

Throughout the Summer and Fall, staff will be reaching out to businesses and residents to discuss how to improve the Town Center experience. This will be in done in conjunction with the current Signage, Circulation and Parking Plan, along with revitalization planning efforts.

Areas to discuss are:

- Improving the arrival awareness for visitors
- Slowing traffic on Tom Darlington Drive and Cave Creek Road
- Creating an improved business/retail environment
- Improving pedestrian/bicycle access and safety for residents
- Addressing other amenities residents would like for Town Center

The intent is to look at comprehensive changes that address these important issues and outlining a plan of future improvements both internal and adjacent to Town Center.

At this time, the initial assessment and first consultant concepts have been completed based upon stakeholder input, and can be found at (web location). Our goal is to gain wider input from the community with plan adoption in Fall 2022. Your input is valuable.

### TOWN BUDGET WORKSHOPS

Every spring, the Town Council holds a series of public workshops to discuss the forecasted Town revenues and planned expenditures for the upcoming fiscal year which starts on July 1st. On Tuesday, April 12th, the Council held its first public workshop. At this workshop a comprehensive presentation was made by Town staff outlining their roles, accomplishments over the past fiscal year, as well as goals for the next fiscal year and some budget considerations.

Considering the fact that Carefree has one of the smallest municipal staffs and operational budgets within the state, this presentation provides an excellent high level understanding of the Town's nimble organizational structure and the value of the professional services and dedication they provide to the Carefree community.

Over 530 homes and businesses on the west and south portions of Carefree have been receiving water service which has been below acceptable standards. Integrating these remaining Carefree accounts into the Carefree Water Company system is one of the Town's primary objectives.

Integration of these accounts into the Carefree Water system is well underway. two neighborhoods (Tranquil Place and The Crossings) are in the process of change-over at time. affected this The balance of neighborhoods are being scheduled as quickly as possible.

A major component of the water system integration is the construction of the water storage reservoir along Tom Darlington Road. The excavation work has now been completed. Next steps are a gravel base and cement pour for the foundation.

Construction is progressing on schedule, and costs are within budgeted expenditures. Construction is anticipated to be finalized by the end of 2022.
