Pavement Preservation Project

Dear Property Owner:

The Town of Carefree is partnering with VSS International to improve and preserve the quality of your streets. VSSI will utilize an innovation in pavement preservation by applying a slurry seal to the streets over an emulsion chip seal. The entire process takes approximately 8 hours, including: pavement preparation and cleaning; application of materials, and curing time of approximately 4-5 hours.

HAVE MY SERVICES BEEN NOTIFIED?

Yes. Local schools, trash service, post office, Fire and Police departments have been notified of the road work.

**Scheduled trash service for day of treatment will be picked up prior to 7 AM.

Please have containers out the night before.**

WHAT IF I DRIVE ON THE ROAD WHILE WORK IS BEING PERFORMED?

Do not drive on the slurry seal application until the street is reopened. You must abide by all traffic control signs and flaggers. Damage to your vehicle will be your responsibility.

You cannot drive on the street until barricades are removed.

There will be travel restrictions and on-street parking is prohibited during this slurry seal application. On the day your street is being treated, please reference the map on the back and plan to park your vehicle on streets not highlighted for that day. Please plan ahead and observe all traffic controls.

After the slurry seal has cured, barricades will be removed & you will be able to drive on the street.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we preserve your Town of Carefree streets.

WORKING STREETS COLOR CODED BY THE DAY SEE MAP ON THE BACK

Play close attention to the "NO Parking Signs"

HOW THIS WILL AFFECT YOU:

- On-street parking is prohibited between 7AM-5PM during this project.
- <u>Turn off sprinklers</u> 24 hours prior to the closure, leave them off during the road closure and for 24 hours after work has been completed. Water may damage the treatment.
- Expect minor delays. Please plan ahead. Observe no parking and other traffic controls.
- If weather causes a halt to the project, your street may be required to be closed another day. If this happens you will receive another notification.
